Local Option Levy to Maintain Fire and Emergency Medical Services

Shall the District levy \$0.27 per \$1,000 of assessed value to maintain general operations for five years, beginning 2020-2021?			
This measure may cause property taxes to increase more than three percent.			
<b>Summary</b> 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect.			
<p>The measure, if approved, would authorize Redmond Fire &amp; Rescue ("the District") to levy taxes to support the annual cost of fire and emergency medical service. The measure would provide for a local option levy at a rate of \$0.27 cents per \$1,000 of taxable assessed value for five years, beginning July 1, 2020. For a home having an assessed value of \$200,000, the estimated annual cost would be \$54.00 per year or about \$4.50 per month.</p> <p>Funds would be used to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Maintain and support paramedic-level response to all life-threatening medical emergencies.</li> <li>* Update cardiac defibrillators, chest compression systems and other life-support equipment.</li> <li>* Replace thermal imagers, firefighting breathing apparatus and other fire suppression equipment.</li> </ul> <p>Total ESTIMATED revenue for each year of the levy:</p> <p>\$1,050,000 in 2020-2021  \$1,081,500 in 2021-2022  \$1,114,000 in 2022-2023  \$1,147,000 in 2023-2024  \$1,180,500 in 2024-2025</p> <p>The estimated tax cost for this measure is an ESTIMATE ONLY, based on the best information available from the county assessor at the time of estimate and may reflect the impact of early payment discounts, compression and the collection rate.</p>
