PROPOSAL: Text Amendments to correct minor errors identified by staff, other County departments, and the public. This process, commonly referred to as Housekeeping, also incorporates updates from rulemaking at the state level through amendments to Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) and Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR), and allows for less substantive code changes to continue efficient County operations.
