



Verification of Domestic and Cistern Water Sources

On March 13, 2002, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Ordinance no. 2002-011 requiring:

- ✓ Applicants for new building permits for properties within water districts to obtain a written statement from the district that the district will provide water or that the subject building is not required to receive water from the district. (DCC 15.04.210)
- ✓ Persons using cisterns as a water source for domestic water purposes need to provide conclusive proof that the source of cistern water is not irrigation water. (DCC 15.04.220)

In order to assist the public and the districts in complying with these requirements, the County has developed this form to be used when an applicant applies for a building permit for new **OR** remodel construction that requires a **plumbing** permit. This form must be signed by a representative from the water or irrigation district and returned with any necessary documentation to Community Development (CDD) **PRIOR** to the building permit being issued.

➤ **Water District Properties – Verification of Domestic Water Source**

➤ **Irrigation District Properties – Verification of Cistern Water Source for Human Consumption**

This form is required for persons using a cistern as storage for water used for human consumption (water used for drinking, cooking, dishwashing, bathing, personal and oral hygiene). Provide conclusive proof such as a well log, contract with a water hauling service or a written statement from a public water supplier or irrigation district that the source of water used to fill the cistern is **NOT** irrigation water.
